problems 24 and 25, I was supposed to divide the two sentences into subject and predicate and find the prepositional phrases. In problem 24, the answer for the subject/predicate part was "he//had", when the word "had" wasn't even in the problem. For problem 25, the answer was "he//thought", neither of which are in the problem.
